Introducing the world's first Motorcycle Crash Rating Tool

Rochester, NY, February 10, 2016: The Street Skills Riding Academy is proud to introduce the world's first Motorcycle Crash Rating Tool (MCRT). Motorcycles are engineered for performance in use. They are not crash-tested for safety.

Riding is risky. Every serious rider knows that. But many don't understand exactly which designs can be the most dangerous. Specific motorcycle model crash testing is not available like it is for cars. In the absence of this information, motorcycle owners and the general public can use this rating system to form an impression of how crashworthy certain models are in frontal collisions (the most common multi-vehicle crash type).

This crashworthiness and prevention rating system is for reflective purposes only and is not scientific. The rating tool is a "rule of thumb" evaluation. Regardless of any particular model's crash rating, be sure to keep your skills sharp and situational awareness at peak performance. Avoiding a crash is always the best outcome.

This checklist assessment was created by Jon DeVecchio (streetskills.net) based on research from James Ouellet and Jesse Wobrock. Ultimately, motorcyclists are responsible for their own safety.
